*Refers to an individual with a solid vision and insightful perspective, extending beyond the expertise surrounding mobility to encompass design and engineering realms.

Acquire expertise regarding "Art/Design," "Philosophy," and "Technology," while also understanding "Sustainability & Human Society."

It is defined as an individual with comprehensive skills who integrates various fields and establishes a platform for project cooperation

■ Proposal to solve social issues in X-City

Applicants define a city (=X-City) and identify its social issues.

City Definition: Either of land, sea, and air domains. It can refer to specific cities such as Yokohama and Nagoya, residential areas, as well as agricultural and fishing zones.
